Status: Full-Time (37.50 hours), Hourly, Benefit Eligible, Salary: \$53,000-\$55,000 annually depending on experience.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. BA or BS recommended in health education or related field, or Associates with equivalent experience.
1. 4 years of experience providing case management and facilitating health education.
2. 1-2 years of experience working in the field of HIV/AIDS or with other chronic illness.
3. Possess an understanding of community level work and the importance of collaborating with other organizations.
4. Excellent communication, writing, and computer skills.
5. Cultural and linguistic competence for the target population. Spanish fluency a plus.
6. Clean driver's license, ability, and means to travel on a flexible schedule as needed.

Responsibilities:

1. Develops and administers educational health education/risk reduction curriculum on various topics that incorporate goals and objectives, frequency, and duration of the sessions.
2. Adheres to AIDS Institute requirements for the provision of Health Education.
3. Provides evaluations with pre and post-education session testing and bi-annual surveys.
4. Participates in the quality management team activities.
5. Completes progress notes and maintains client records that document attendance, participation, progress, accomplishments, and additional needs, referrals, and goals.
6. Enter all services into the Agency EHR, AIRS, and referrals in Unite Us within 48 hours of service.
7. Fully support and grow the Damien Center Pharmacy Program and work to support members in reducing barriers to help each person achieve durable HIV Viral Load Suppression.
8. Support and participate in a culture of philanthropy by recognizing that fundraising efforts—including donor relations and organizational agency communication—include all staff and are essential to carry out the work and mission of the organization. Assist in securing member stories and participating in fundraising efforts as requested by supervisor.
9. Fully engage in self-care to promote physical, emotional, and spiritual well-being.
10. Attend full staff meetings and meet required 24 hours of annual training
11. Other duties as assigned.
